The Special Assembly of the Diocese of Philadelphia and Eastern Pennsylvania of the Orthodox Church in America, was held on February 19, 1981, at Holy Resurrection Orthodox Cathedral in Wilkes-Barre, Pa.

**PLENARY SESSION**

After Divine Liturgy, served by His Beatitude Metropolitan THEODOSIUS and, His Grace Bishop HERMAN; and short break, the Assembly was opened at 12:30 with the singing of "The Grace of the Holy Spirit...".

AGENDA

His Beatitude, Metropolitan THEODOSIUS reviewed the instructions concerning the "Instructions concerning the Election of the Ruling Bishop". He corrected Item #15 to read:

"...date and place of the consecration and/or installation of the new bishop..."

ADDRESS OF THE METROPOLITAN

His Beatitude addressed the Assembly, stating the election of a ruling bishop was not the same as political elections. He stressed, quoting from Ephesians 4:11, 12, the election of a bishop should be guided by the Holy Spirit, as all are called into specific roles in the Church.

NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES

His Beatitude announced, that the name of His Grace Bishop HERMAN, Bishop of Wilkes-Barre, had been placed into nomination by the special Diocesan Council, for the position of Bishop of Philadelphia and Eastern Pennsylvania. This special council was convened on the 40th day commemoration of the falling asleep of Archbishop KIPRIAN.

At this time, nominations were accepted from the floor. The name of Fr. Thomas Jones was placed into nomination by Mr. Krenitsky.

There were no other nominations from the floor and the nominations were closed.

ELECTION OF THE RULING BISHOP

The tellers passed out the first ballot, and the voting took place during the singing of "O Lord, save Thy people."

The first ballot was counted and His Beatitude announced that His Grace Bishop HERMAN had, by an overwhelming majority, been elected as the Bishop of Philadelphia and Eastern Pennsylvania. The results were as follows:

Bishop HERMAN:	66
Fr. Thomas Jones:	11
Void:	1
Total:	78

His Beatitude noted that the name, of Bishop HERMAN, would be placed before the Holy Synod for confirmation at the Spring Session on March 17, 1981. At that time, Bishop HERMAN would become the ruling Bishop of the Diocese. Until then, His Beatitude would remain in Locum Tenens.
