SEMINARIAN APPEAL BILL RUSK AND FAMILY

Dear to God,

Christ is in our midst! He is and ever shall be! The V. Rev. Fr. Nicholas Solak reminded me that we have another seminarian this year, Bill Rusk from Holy Trinity, Stroudsburg. He previously took courses at St Tikhon's but will complete his degree in one year at St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary in NY.

As mentioned in my previous letter, seminarians are responsible for raising half their tuition money each semester, approximately \$3,155, as well as cover costs of books, supplies, rent, utilities, groceries, etc. Rent is not cheap and housing keeps getting more costly regardless of where one lives. St Vladimir's has a matching Grant Program which requires the students to raise half their tuition money.

Our parishes and faithful have been very generous in supporting our seminarians in the past and I pray you will continue to do so. There is a shortage of priest in our Diocese as well as the OCA. We need to show our support for our seminarians so that they will want to return to serve one of our parishes. A one time gift or monthly support would also be greatly appreciated.
